## LEAVE OF ABSENCE (HOLIDAY)

As you know, we are unable to authorise any Leave of Absence during term time except in extremely exceptional circumstances.

- If your child will be absent for a holiday, you must fill in a Leave of Absence form before you go so that we know where your child is.
- A referral will be made to the Education Welfare Service for a Penalty Warning **if the total number of days of Leave of Absence in an academic year** is 6 or more. Multiple Leave of Absence requests are added together.
- If a child is absent due to illness immediately before or after their Leave of Absence, **these days will be included in the Leave of Absence** unless you provide us with medical evidence of their illness or proof of the dates of the holiday.

**PLEASE NOTE:** There are proposed changes to the law around leave of absence (holiday fines) which will come into place from September 2024 that state fines should be issued after 5 days of absence.
