A time for picnics and rest in the shade...


Lord,

Dear parents and carers,

As I am sure you agree, we are very proud of our school, our children and how smartly they dress. We believe that a smart uniform, worn neatly and tidily, helps to instill a sense of pride and loyalty to the school, as well as helping to improve behaviour.

With that in mind, may I politely remind everyone of uniform expectations so that children are ready for next year in September:

SHOES:

- Children should wear black, leather-style school shoes. Black trainers are **not** to be worn.



- Black school shoes should be worn with black/white socks or grey tights for girls.

TIES:

- Please ensure that children arrive every day wearing a school tie (unless wearing a blue summer dress). We keep a small stock of ties, both elastic and standard, in stock in school which can be purchased through Scopay for £4.50.
