RE: Remote Learning

Thank you for your continued support with the extremely short notice school closures that were announced last night. Our aims to ensure that your children's education will continue with as little disruption as possible. From 1pm this afternoon, children in year 2 to year 6 will have access remote lessons via Teams. As of Wednesday 5th January, children are expected to access all lesson from 9am – 3pm to ensure that they can continue to make the wonderful progress that they are capable of. It is really important that your child is punctual for all lessons and attends all lessons. Lateness and absence from lessons will be recorded as normal.

Your child's class teacher will provide a full timetable including the timings of breaks throughout the day. Children who access all lessons and submit all work to the expected standard will be rewarded on a daily basis with achievement points. If your child is unwell and therefore not able to access remote learning, absence should be reported to the school office as per normal procedures.

Teams will be used to access remote teaching from year 2 - 6. A daily link will be sent to your child's email in order for them to access their daily lessons.

The following expectations for all remote lessons are set out below.

- Children must wear suitable clothing, as should anyone else in the household.
- Children's webcams should normally be switched off.
- Any computers/devices used should be in appropriate areas, for example, preferably not in bedrooms.
- Children's microphones should be switched off unless children are answering or asking specific questions or unless they are answering their name in the register.
- All tasks should be submitted to the teacher via the assignments on Teams in order for the teachers to provide feedback on their work.
- A member of the senior management team will visit the online lessons to provide support for staff and provide further safeguarding reassurances.

If your child will have difficulties accessing the appropriate technology, please do not hesitate to contact the school office.
